

# Instructions for using Super HDQ



Super HDQ is a very good disinfectant. However, in its concentrated form it is very caustic. So be careful in handling it so that you do not get it on your skin in its concentrated form. Here is how to use it:

1. For routine cleaning and disinfecting it needs to be diluted to one half ounce per gallon. That requires making up a gallon of it at a time to be Ready to Use (RTU). Fill an empty gallon jug with water and add one half ounce of concentrate to the gallon using the measuring device that we have. You squeeze the bottle until the proper amount is in the cup. This eliminates the danger of getting it on your skin.
2. Please make sure to have labels to properly mark the container. They are available from the supplier. If you have empty bottles that are labeled with another product the label is easily removed by filling the bottle with as hot water as you can get. Let it set for 15 to 30 seconds and then you should be able to peel the label off easily.
3. For mopping floors, you will need to add one half ounce of concentrate per gallon to your mop bucket of water. Please remember to always add the water first and then add the chemical to the water. That eliminates the possibility of the chemical being splashed on you when you add the water. I recommend using a quart bottle with the measuring device on it to send it out to the locations. It is easier to handle than a gallon jug, but you can determine what would be in the best interest of the situation.
